National Holiday for All Native American Code Talkers Resolution

Whereas the Native Americans recognize the Federal and State governments, therefore it is befitting for the Federal Government to recognize All Native American Code-Talkers with the establishment of a National Holiday for all Native American Code-Talkers;

Whereas there are ten national holidays now recognized by the Federal Government, not one paying tribute to all Native American Code-Talkers;

Whereas the Native American people need a Federal holiday to help recognize All Native American Code Talkers for their contributions to United States for all wars in which they fought in and were associated with, especially World War I and World War II.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the United States Government support and promote a recommendation to designate one day each year as a Federal Native American Cold Talkers Holiday recognizing Native American Indians who participated in the many US Wars including and especially World War I and II;

BE IT RESOLVED that the United States Federal Government support and promote a recommendation to pay tribute to the Native American Code-Talkers by establishing a Federal day that will be included along with the ten national holidays that the United States Federal Government supports;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the United States Federal Government establishes such a holiday with the intent to show solidarity and identification with the Native American Government as well as the Native American Code-Talkers in recognition of their historic involvement in the formation of Federal and State Governments we have today, including service in the United States Armed Services.
