On behalf of the Division of Care and Treatment Services, which operates the state's three Intellectual and Developmental Disability Centers – Central Wisconsin Center, Northern Wisconsin Center, and Southern Wisconsin Center – the Department of Health Services is submitting its response to Wis. Stat. § 46.275(5m).

In calendar year 2023 neither Central Wisconsin Center nor Northern Wisconsin Center had a Community Integration Program (CIP) 1A discharge, and therefore, no employee impact attributable to CIP 1A.
