
Dear Chief Clerk Fuller:

In accordance with s. 115.28 (39), Wis. Stats., the Department of Public Instruction is required to submit biennially a report to the chief clerks of each house of the legislature evaluating the effectiveness of alcohol and other drug abuse programs. Additionally, pursuant to s. 115.36 (3) (a) 4., Wis. Stats., the department shall include as a part of its biennial report submission under s. 15.04 (1) (d), Wis. Stats., a report on program progress and project evaluation of alcohol and other drug abuse programs.

The department submits this letter to bring attention to this duplicative requirement. As a result, to meet the requirements under s. 115.28 (39), Stats., the department is notifying the chief clerks of the legislature to refer to pages 40 to 43 in its 2017-19 biennial report submission, which was submitted on October 15th, 2019 and is located at https://dpi.wi.gov/sites/default/files/imce/policy-budget/pdf/DPI_2017-19_Biennial_Report_FINAL_Oct_15_2019.pdf.
