SECTION III: ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE OF CHARTER SCHOOLS

The WCEC Alternative High School focuses academic instruction on the core disciplines of Mathematics, Science, Social Studies and English/Language Arts for their programs – Competency, 17 credit Diploma, and Senior Skills (GED Option 2). Successful academic achievement leads to graduation with a high school diploma. In the 2018-2019 school year, the school had 68 graduates. Of the graduating class, four students did not graduate by the end of the spring term. The students continued throughout the summer to finish their requirements. Two of the four students are continuing with their enrollment to finish in the 2019-20 school year. The graduation percentage, counting the completers is 94% for the 2018-2019 school year. Students enrolled in grades 11 and 12 took approximately 38 courses from Gateway Technical College.

To achieve credit in their subjects, students are required to meet a standard level of achievement of 70% or higher in their daily work. At the end of the spring semester, 90% of students in 12th grade were achieving at an academic level of 70% or greater.

The OPtions Virtual Charter School serves students in 4K-12. Students in 4K-8 are evaluated through a portfolio process containing teacher directed assignments and summative evaluations Students in grades 9-12 are assigned traditional letter grades and must earn a 60% or higher to earn credit for a course.

OPtions Virtual Charter School state report card achievement data for English Language Arts and Mathematics using grades 3-8 Forward Exam and 11th grade ACT results indicate we have a school score of 62.9/100 which exceeds the state average Options Virtual School also received a score of 97.4/100 for On-track and Postsecondary Readiness, also exceeding the state average.
