OSC students participate in MAP Math and Literacy testing 3 times per year. The scores are comparable to the other 3rd-5th grade students in the district. They took the Forward Exam along with the rest of the district. Their state report card scored in the Meets Expectations category.

SECTION IV: FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE OF CHARTER SCHOOLS

OSC is an instrumentality of the District and its costs fall within the scope of the District's annual required audit.

The school's Governing Board is responsible for allocating costs for OSC curriculum, determined on an equal per-pupil basis as the remainder of the District's curriculum budget. In 2018-19 this amount was \$12,545.

All financial stipulations of the charter contract were fulfilled in 2018-19.

- Support Staff: 0.50 FTE (school year)

Special education and related services are provided by the District based upon individual student need and are not specifically assigned or allocated to OSC.

Food service, transportation, maintenance, information technology, general administration, and other auxiliary services are provided at the District level and not specifically assigned or allocated to OSC.
