## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 13, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 64

September 13, 2017 - Offered by Representatives Mason, Barca, Bowen, Wachs, Zepnick and Sinicki.

- 1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
- 2 **1.** Page 742, line 18: after that line insert:
- 3 "Section 1463j. 115.28 (10p) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 115.28 (10p) School district creation study; eligible unified school
- 5 DISTRICTS. Study whether the creation of a new school district under s. 117.105 (4m)
- 6 will have a disparate impact on children with disabilities, as defined in s. 115.76 (5),
- 7 limited-English proficient pupils, as defined in s. 115.955 (7), minority group pupils,
- 8 as defined in s. 121.845 (2), and pupils who satisfy the income eligibility criteria for
- 9 a free or reduced-price lunch under 42 USC 1758 (b) (1).".
- 10 **2.** Page 776, line 14: delete "Within" and substitute "Subject to par. (e), within".
  - **3.** Page 777, line 3: delete "If" and substitute "Subject to par. (e), if".

4.	Page	777,	line 9:	after	that	line	insert:

- "(e) A village may not proceed under par. (c) or (d) unless a study conducted under s. 115.28 (10p) demonstrates that creating a new school district under s. 117.105 (4m) will not have disparate impact on any of the following enrolled in the eligible unified school district:
  - 1. Children with disabilities, as defined in s. 115.76 (5).
  - 2. Limited-English proficient pupils, as defined in s. 115.955 (7).
    - 3. Minority group pupils, as defined in s. 121.845 (2).
- 9 4. Pupils who satisfy the income eligibility criteria for a free or reduced-price lunch under 42 USC 1758 (b) (1).".
