**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 14,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 64**

September 13, 2017 - Offered by Representatives MASON, BARCA, BOWEN, WACHS,
ZEPNICK and SINICKI.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 281, line 22: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 208mb.** 20.255 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 20.255 (2) (b) *Aids for special education and school age parents programs.* The
5 amounts in the schedule for the payment of aids to school districts other than an
6 eligible school district, as defined in s. 118.60 (1) (am), for special education and
7 school age parents programs under ss. 115.88, 115.93 and 118.255.

8 **SECTION 208md.** 20.255 (2) (bd) of the statutes is amended to read:

9 20.255 (2) (bd) *Additional special education aid.* The amounts in the schedule
10 for the payment of aid under s. 115.881 to school districts other than an eligible school
11 district, as defined in s. 118.60 (1) (am).

12 **SECTION 208mf.** 20.255 (2) (be) of the statutes is amended to read:

1 20.255 (2) (be) *Supplemental special education aid*. The amounts in the
2 schedule for the payment of supplemental special education aid under s. 115.883 to
3 school districts other than an eligible school district, as defined in s. 118.60 (1) (am).”.

4 **2.** Page 282, line 3: after that line insert:

5 “**SECTION 208nb.** 20.255 (2) (bi) of the statutes is created to read:

6 20.255 (2) (bi) *Additional aid for eligible school districts; special education and*
7 *bilingual-bicultural aids*. A sum sufficient for the payment of aids under ss. 115.88.
8 115.881, 115.883, 115.93, and 118.255 to an eligible school district, as defined in s.
9 118.60 (1) (am), and for bilingual-bicultural education programs under subch. VII
10 of ch. 115 in an eligible school district, as defined in s. 118.60 (1) (am).”.

11 **3.** Page 282, line 13: after that line insert:

12 “**SECTION 208u.** 20.255 (2) (cc) of the statutes is amended to read:

13 20.255 (2) (cc) *Bilingual-bicultural education aids*. The amounts in the
14 schedule for bilingual-bicultural education programs under subch. VII of ch. 115 in
15 school districts other than an eligible school district, as defined in s. 118.60 (1) (am).”.

16 **4.** Page 770, line 2: after “(b)” insert “or (bi)”.

17 **5.** Page 771, line 17: delete “(b).” and substitute “(b):”.

18 **6.** Page 771, line 19: delete “eosts.” and substitute “eosts or (bi)”.

19 **7.** Page 772, line 14: after “(b)” insert “or (bi)”.

20 **8.** Page 772, line 16: after that line insert:

21 “**SECTION 1503d.** 115.88 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

22 115.88 (3) **BOARD AND LODGING AID**. There shall be paid the amount expended
23 for board and lodging and transportation between the boarding home and the special
24 education program of nonresident children enrolled under s. 115.82 (1) in the special

1 education program. The department shall certify to the department of
2 administration in favor of each school district, cooperative educational service
3 agency, county children with disabilities education board, state agency of another
4 state or private, nonsectarian special education service which operates the special
5 education program while providing board, lodging and transportation an amount
6 equal to the amount expended for such board and lodging and transportation as costs
7 eligible for reimbursement from the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (b) or (bi).

8 **SECTION 1503f.** 115.88 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

9 115.88 (4) HOSPITALS AND CONVALESCENT HOME AID. The full cost of special
10 education for children in hospitals and convalescent homes for orthopedically
11 disabled children shall be paid from the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (b) or (bi).
12 The supervision of such instruction shall be under the department and the school
13 board of the school district in which the hospital or convalescent home is located. The
14 school board of the district in which the hospital or convalescent home is located shall
15 submit to the department an itemized statement of all revenues and expenditures
16 for the actual cost of such instruction and any other information it requires.

17 **SECTION 1503h.** 115.88 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:

18 115.88 (6) AID FOR INSTRUCTION OUTSIDE OF DISTRICT. The department shall
19 certify to the department of administration, in favor of each school district, an
20 amount equal to the amount expended for salaries and travel expenses, as
21 determined in advance by the state superintendent, for providing special education
22 outside the school district of employment, as eligible for reimbursement from the
23 appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (b) or (bi).

24 **SECTION 1503j.** 115.88 (8) of the statutes is amended to read:

1 115.88 (8) ENROLLMENT OUT OF STATE. If a child with a disability is enrolled in
2 a public special education program located in another state and the state
3 superintendent is satisfied that the program in which the child is enrolled complies
4 with this subchapter, the state superintendent shall certify to the department of
5 administration in favor of the school district in which the child resides or the school
6 district attended by the child under s. 118.50, 118.51, or 121.84 (1) (a) or (4) a sum
7 equal to the amount expended by the school district during the preceding year for the
8 additional costs associated with the child's special education program as costs
9 eligible for reimbursement from the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (b) or (bi)."

10 **9.** Page 772, line 23: after "(bd)" insert "or (bi)".

11 **10.** Page 772, line 25: after that line insert:

12 **"SECTION 1504cd.** 115.881 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

13 115.881 (3) If the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (bd) or (bi) is insufficient
14 to pay the full amount of costs under sub. (2), the department shall prorate payments
15 among eligible applicants.

16 **SECTION 1504cg.** 115.883 (1) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

17 115.883 (1) (intro.) Beginning in the 2008-09 school year, from the
18 appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (be) or (bi), the department shall pay supplemental
19 special education aid to school districts to which all of the following apply:"

20 **11.** Page 775, line 7: after that line insert:

21 **"SECTION 1504jd.** 115.93 of the statutes is amended to read:

22 **115.93 State aid.** If upon receipt of the reports under s. 115.92 (2) the state
23 superintendent is satisfied that the school age parents program has been maintained
24 during the preceding school year in accordance with the rules under s. 115.92 (3), the

1 state superintendent shall certify to the department of administration in favor of
2 each school district maintaining the program a sum equal to the amount expended
3 by the school district during the preceding school year for salaries of teachers and
4 instructional aides, special transportation and other expenses approved by the state
5 superintendent as costs eligible for reimbursement from the appropriation under s.
6 20.255 (2) (b) or (bi).

7 **SECTION 1504jk.** 115.995 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

8 115.995 (1) From the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (cc), divide
9 proportionally, based upon costs reported under s. 115.993, an annual payment of
10 \$250,000 among school districts other than an eligible school district, as defined in
11 s. 118.60 (1) (am) whose enrollments in the previous school year were at least 15
12 percent limited-English proficient pupils. Aid paid under this subsection does not
13 reduce aid paid under sub. (2).

14 **SECTION 1504jn.** 115.995 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

15 115.995 (2) Certify to the department of administration in favor of the school
16 district a sum equal to a percentage of the amount expended on limited-English
17 proficient pupils by the school district during the preceding year for salaries of
18 personnel participating in and attributable to bilingual-bicultural education
19 programs under this subchapter, special books and equipment used in the
20 bilingual-bicultural programs and other expenses approved by the state
21 superintendent. The percentage shall be determined by dividing the amount in the
22 appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (cc) in the current school year less \$250,000 by the
23 total amount of aidable costs in the previous school year for school districts other
24 than an eligible school district, as defined in s. 118.60 (1) (am).

25 **SECTION 1504jp.** 115.995 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

1 115.995 **(3)** From the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (bi), pay to an eligible
2 school district, as defined in s. 118.60 (1) (am), the amount expended on
3 limited-English proficient pupils by the eligible school district during the preceding
4 year for salaries of personnel participating in and attributable to
5 bilingual-bicultural education programs under this subchapter, special books and
6 equipment used in the bilingual-bicultural programs and other expenses approved
7 by the state superintendent.”.

8 **12.** Page 792, line 20: after that line insert:

9 “**SECTION 1525m.** 118.255 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

10 118.255 **(4)** If the state superintendent is satisfied that the health treatment
11 services program has been maintained during the preceding school year in
12 accordance with law, the state superintendent shall certify to the department of
13 administration in favor of each school board, cooperative educational service agency
14 and county children with disabilities education board maintaining such health
15 treatment services, an amount equal to the amount expended for items listed in s.
16 115.88 (1m) by the school board, cooperative educational service agency and county
17 children with disabilities education board during the preceding year for these health
18 treatment services as costs eligible for reimbursement from the appropriation under
19 s. 20.255 (2) (b) or (bi).”.
