

WHEREAS, a petition of John W. Spragg, Sr. has been filed with me pursuant to the provisions of section 12.22 of the Wisconsin Statutes alleging that you, Harold J. Holloman, have violated certain provisions of chapter 12, to wit: sections 12.13 and 12.17 as a candidate for judge of the County of Waushara; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of section 12.22(2) require that you be summoned to appear before me in an informal hearing to give you an opportunity to challenge and answer the allegations made in the petition and to confront the petitioner and adverse witnesses;

NOW, THEREFORE, you are hereby ordered to appear before me on the 10th day of March, 1966 at 1:30 in the afternoon to answer the allegations contained in the petition hereto annexed in order to permit me to make a determination "if there is probable cause to believe that such proceedings may be successfully maintained in an action commenced for the purpose as provided by the statutes in such case made and provided."
