



WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of Member of the Assembly representing Milwaukee County, 22nd District, caused by the appointment of State Representative Robert T. Huber to the position of Highway Commissioner and his resignation as State Representative on the 10th day of December, 1971, which term of office would have expired on the 1st day of January, 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARTIN J. SCHREIBER, Acting Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby order that a Special Election be held to coincide with the Spring Primary in Milwaukee County, 22nd District, the State of Wisconsin, on the 4th day of April, A.D., 1972, to fill said vacancy, that the Special Primary be held on the 7th day of March, A.D., 1972, and that said Special Election and Special Primary shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
