

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 74

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of the Municipal Judge for the Village of Paddock Lake, in the county of Kenosha, State of Wisconsin, as a result of the resignation on April 28, 1981, of Bruce R. Andersen whose term of office would have expired on April 30, 1983;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby order that a Special Election, to fill the existing vacancy, be held.

IF, nomination for such office is to be accomplished by the circulation of nomination papers, then the Special Election shall be held on September 1, 1981. The circulation of nominating papers for candidates may commence on June 16, 1981, the deadline for filing nomination papers for candidates shall be 5:00 P.M., July 7, 1981. The special primary shall be held on August 4, 1981.

IF, nomination for such office is to be accomplished by the holding of a nominating caucus, then the nominating caucus shall be held in accordance with Section 8.05(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes on or before July 7, 1981, and the Special Election shall be held on August 4, 1981.

AND, the election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.


FURTHER, I hereby declare that this Executive Order No. 74, supercedes Executive Order No. 69, issued May 9, 1981.
