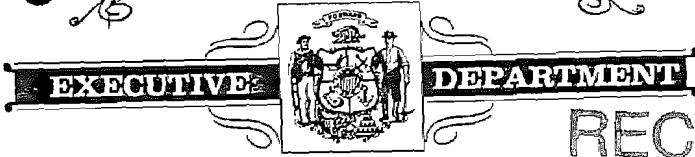

WHEREAS, Executive Order 96 of the Dreyfus Administration created the Civil Rights Compliance Task Force; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order Three of the Earl Administration extended the existence of the Civil Rights Compliance Task Force; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 28 of the Earl Administration gave authority to the Secretary of the Department of Employment Relations to administer a comprehensive and coordinated statewide service delivery and equal employment opportunity program, so there is no longer a need for the Task Force;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTHONY S. EARL, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby abolish the Civil Rights Compliance Task Force.
