EXECUTIVE ORDER #44

Relating to a Special Election in the Third Senate District.

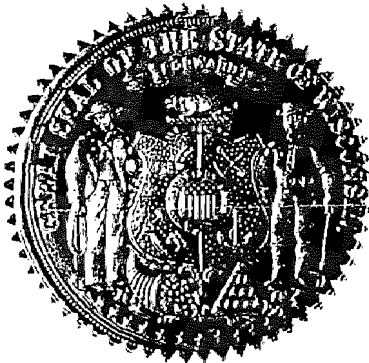
WHEREAS, State Senator John O. Norquist was elected on November 4, 1986 to represent the Third Senate District; and

WHEREAS, State Senator John O. Norquist was elected Mayor of Milwaukee on April 5, 1988; and

WHEREAS, State Senator John O. Norquist has resigned his position as a State Senator, representing the Third Senate District, in accordance with s. 17.01(3), Wis. Stats.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 8.50, order that a special election be held on November 8, 1988 to fill the vacancy in the Third Senate District, as described in Wis. Stats. sec. 4.009(3), for a term expiring the day preceding the first Monday in January, 1991 and that if a primary is necessary, it be held on September 13, 1988. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 pm, July 12, 1988. The election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
