

EXECUTIVE ORDER #73

Relating to the Wisconsin Adjutant General Selection Committee

WHEREAS, Major General Raymond Matera has submitted his resignation as Adjutant General of the Wisconsin National Guard effective December 1, 1989; and

WHEREAS, it is desireable to have those familiar with the Wisconsin National Guard and the position of the Adjutant General involved in the process to select the next Adjutant General;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 14.019, do hereby:

- 1. Create the Wisconsin Adjutant General Selection Committee; and
- Provide that the Committee shall consist of five members, appointed by the Governor to serve at his pleasure; and
- 3. Direct that the Wisconsin Adjutant General Selection Committee:
 - (a) solicit applications from those persons statutorily eligible for and interested in the position of Adjutant General of the Wisconsin National Guard;
 - (b) take such action as will allow the Committee to evaluate the abilities of those applicants; and
 - (c) submit a recommendation to me by November 15, 1989 as to the applicant best suited to be the next Adjutant General of the Wisconsin National Guard; and
- 4. Direct the Secretary of the Department of Administration, pursuant to s. 20.503(3)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes to provide the Wisconsin Adjutant General Selection Committee with sums of money, if necessary, for legitimate operating expenses and for the travel expenses of the Committee, if needed.
