EXECUTIVE ORDER #187

Relating to a Proclamation that the National and State Flags be Flown at Half Staff due to the Death of Former Governor Warren P. Knowles

WHEREAS, the Honorable Warren P. Knowles served as Governor of the State of Wisconsin from January 4, 1965 until January 4, 1971; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Warren P. Knowles died on May 1, 1993;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby:

Order that the National and State flags on all State buildings and State grounds be flown at half-staff beginning May 3, 1993, until interment on May 5, 1993.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this third day of May in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-three.
