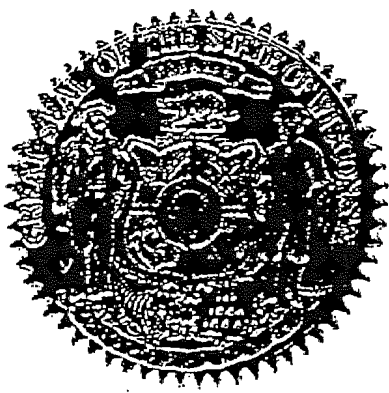

EXECUTIVE ORDER #204


Relating to a Special Election for the Twentieth State Senate District

WHEREAS, State Senator Donald K. Stitt submitted his resignation as a State Senator for the Twentieth Senate District, effective Wednesday, July 21, 1993;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute section 8.50(4)(e) order that a special election be held on September 21, 1993 to fill the vacancy in the Twentieth Senate District. A description of the boundaries of the Twentieth Senate District as created in Prosser et. al. v. Elections Board et. al., Civil Action 92-C-0078-C (W.D. Wis. 1992) is set out in the 1991-92 Wisconsin Statutes following s.4.005. The term will expire on the first Monday in January, 1995 and, if a primary is necessary, it shall be held on August 24, 1993. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., July 27, 1993. This election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
