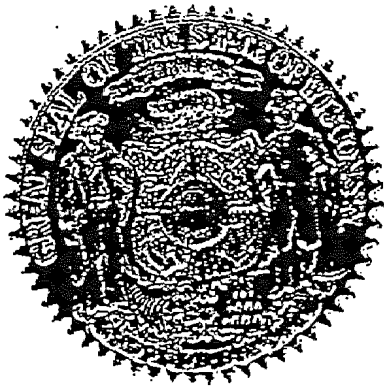
EXECUTIVE ORDER #206

Proclamation of a State of Emergency


WHEREAS, natural disaster caused by severe storms and flooding beginning on June 7, 1993, in Dodge, Jefferson, Kenosha, Milwaukee and Racine Counties in the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, such severe weather creates emergencies of concern to the State of Wisconsin;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 166.03 (1)(b)(1), do hereby proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in Dodge, Jefferson, Kenosha, Milwaukee and Racine Counties.



IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this twenty-first day of July in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-three.
