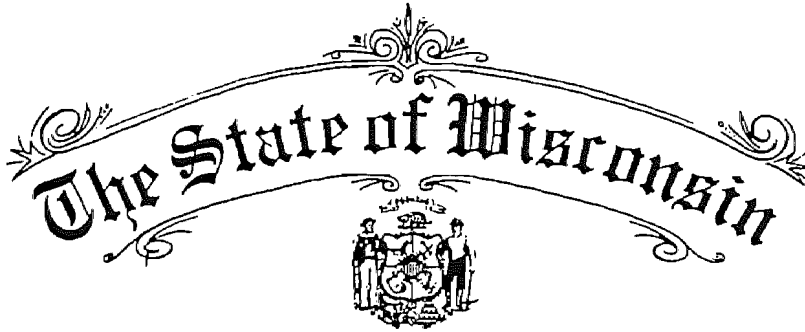

Relating to a Proclamation Ordering that the National and State Flags be Flown at Half-Staff Due to the Death of Chancellor J. Martin Klotsche

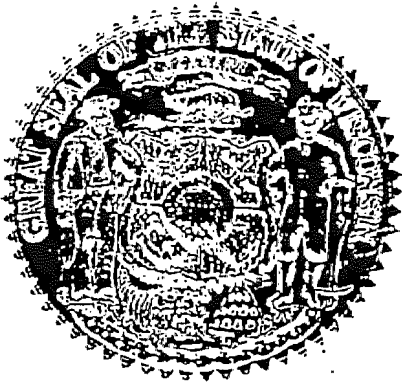
WHEREAS, Chancellor J. Martin Klotsche served as Chancellor of the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee with honor and distinction; and


WHEREAS, Chancellor J. Martin Klotsche died on Saturday, February 4, 1995:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby:

Order that the National and State flags on all University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee grounds be flown at half staff beginning February 7, 1995, at 3:00 p.m. until sundown February 10, 1995.
