**Proclamation of a State of Emergency**

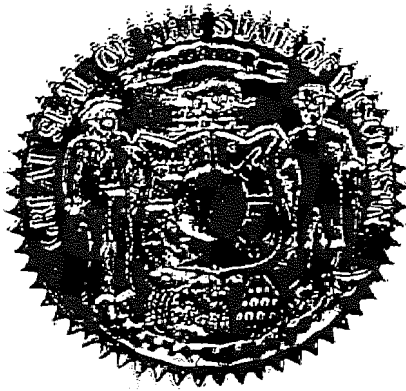
WHEREAS, severe thunderstorms, flooding and high winds occurred in the State of Wisconsin on or about August 28, 1995; and

WHEREAS, such severe thunderstorms, flooding and high winds caused extensive damage in the State of Wisconsin amounting to a natural disaster; and

WHEREAS, such natural disaster affected Milwaukee County and other counties.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 166.03 (1) (b) (1), do hereby proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in Milwaukee County.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this fifth day of September in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-five.
