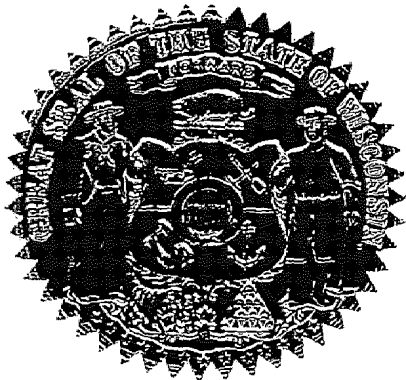
EXECUTIVE ORDER # 174

Relating to the Suspension of Craig Haukaas
as District Attorney of Bayfield County


WHEREAS, The Office of the Governor has been credibly informed that Craig Haukaas, District Attorney of Bayfield County, has been charged with one count of misdemeanor bail jumping as party to a crime, pursuant to Sections 946.49(1)(a), 939.05(2)(c), and 939.31 of the Wisconsin Statutes; and one count of felony misconduct in public office, pursuant to Section 946.12(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Section 17.11 (1) of the Wisconsin Statutes requires the Governor to suspend any district attorney of this state who has been charged with a felony;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this state, and specifically by section 17.11 (1) of the Wisconsin Statutes, DO HERBY SUSPEND Craig Haukaas as District Attorney of Bayfield County effective as of November 21, 2006. This order shall remain in force until the above referenced charges have been investigated and finally determined.
