EXECUTIVE ORDER #139

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Private First Class Donnell A. Hamilton, Jr. of the United States Army, Who Lost His Life While Serving His Country

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2014, Private First Class Donnell A. Hamilton, Jr., of Kenosha, Wisconsin, a member of the 1st Battalion, 5th Cavalry Regiment, 2nd Brigade Combat Team, 1st Cavalry Division, Fort Hood, Texas, died from an illness sustained while serving in Afghanistan; and

WHEREAS, Private First Class Donnell A. Hamilton, Jr. faithfully served the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Private First Class Donnell A. Hamilton, Jr.; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Private First Class Donnell A. Hamilton, Jr. on August 2, 2014;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State and by federal law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags, beginning at sunrise on **Saturday, August 2, 2014**, and ending at sunset on that date.
