EXECUTIVE ORDER #162

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff in Memory of Calumet County Highway Department Employee Derrick Burkhalter

WHEREAS, on Monday, May 4, 2015, Derrick Burkhalter, an employee of the Calumet County Department of Highways, died from injuries suffered in a tragic vehicle crash while on the job working along U.S. Highway 10; and

WHEREAS, Derrick Burkhalter was a native of Wisconsin and a valued member of his community in the Calumet County area; and

WHEREAS, Derrick Burkhalter served his community as an employee of the Calumet County Highway Department for over nine years; and

WHEREAS, Derrick Burkhalter served the people of the United States and the people of the State of Wisconsin as a member of the United States Army; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Derrick Burkhalter on Saturday, May 9, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Calumet County has petitioned the Office of the Governor to approve the lowering of the flags;


