EXECUTIVE ORDER #195

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin May Be Flown at Half-Staff in the City of Greenfield as a Mark of Respect for Deputy Chief Richard Karweik of the Greenfield Police Department

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, March 29, 2016, retired Deputy Chief Richard Karweik of the Greenfield Police Department passed away at the age of 77; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Chief Richard Karweik was one of six founding members of the Greenfield Police Department in 1962; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Chief Richard Karweik served in the Greenfield Police Department with distinction for thirty-two years, culminating in his service as Interim Chief of Police from 1993 until his retirement in 1994; and


WHEREAS, Deputy Chief Richard Karweik was a dedicated public servant who made many significant contributions to the City of Greenfield and the Greenfield Police Department throughout his career, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his passing; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Deputy Chief Richard Karweik on Saturday, April 2, 2016;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby authorize that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin may be flown at half-staff throughout the City of Greenfield, beginning at sunrise on **Saturday, April 2, 2016**, and ending at sunset on that date.
