EXECUTIVE ORDER #234

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Firefighter Terrance E. Shafer of the Spring Valley Fire Department

WHEREAS, on Saturday, February 25, 2017, Terrance E. Shafer, a volunteer firefighter with the Spring Valley Fire Department in Spring Valley, Wisconsin, died in the line of duty at the age of sixty-two after responding to a motor vehicle crash; and

WHEREAS, Terrance E. Shafer served as a firefighter for thirty-eight years including thirty years as the Chief of the Spring Valley Fire Department from 1986 to 2016; and


WHEREAS, Terrance E. Shafer leaves behind an honorable legacy of public service, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his death; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Terrance E. Shafer in Spring Valley, Wisconsin, on Friday, March 3, 2017;


NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags, beginning at sunrise on **Friday, March 3, 2017**, and ending at sunset on that date.
