EXECUTIVE ORDER #282

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Former Wisconsin Attorney General Bronson La Follette

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2018, former Wisconsin Attorney General Bronson La Follette passed away at the age of 82; and

WHEREAS, Attorney General Bronson La Follette was appointed Assistant U.S. Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin in 1962; and

WHEREAS, Attorney General Bronson La Follette was first elected Wisconsin Attorney General in 1964 at the age of 28, becoming the youngest Attorney General elected to office in American history; and

WHEREAS, after winning election in 1964, Attorney General Bronson La Follette served two consecutive two-year terms and, after being elected again in 1974, served three four-year terms as Wisconsin Attorney General; and

WHEREAS, Attorney General Bronson La Follette was a dedicated public servant, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his passing; and

WHEREAS, a memorial program and celebration of Attorney General Bronson La Follette's life will be held on Saturday, April 7, 2018;


NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin, beginning at sunrise on **Saturday, April 7, 2018**, and ending at sunset on that date.
