EXECUTIVE ORDER #99

Relating to a Special Election for the Eighty-Ninth Assembly District

WHEREAS, State Representative John Nygren submitted his resignation December 2, 2020, as State Representative for the Eighty-Ninth Assembly District.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to article IV, section 14 of the Wisconsin Constitution and Section 8.50(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes, order that a special election shall be held on April 6, 2021, to fill the vacancy in the Eighty-Ninth Assembly District, as created in 2011 Act 43, and whose boundaries are set out in Section 4.89 of the Wisconsin Statutes. A copy of the boundary descriptions may be obtained from the Elections Commission or the Legislative Reference Bureau. The term of office for the Eighty-Ninth Assembly District will expire on the first Monday in January 2023. If a primary is necessary, it shall be held on February 16, 2021. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin today, December 18, 2020, and nomination papers shall be filed no later than 5:00:00 p.m. on January 8, 2021, in the office of the Elections Commission, 212 East Washington Avenue, Third Floor, Madison, Wisconsin. These elections shall be held, conducted, canvassed, and returned in accordance of law.
