



## 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 85

January 31, 1995 - Introduced by Representatives BELL, SCHNEIDER, BOYLE, BALDWIN, CARPENTER, GROBSCHMIDT, LINTON, MORRIS-TATUM, R. POTTER, PLACHE, ROBSON, R. YOUNG, L. YOUNG, WIRCH, WILDER, ALBERS, DUFF, MUSSER and OURADA, cosponsored by Senators BURKE and PLEWA. Referred to Committee on Highways and Transportation.

1     **AN ACT to amend** 343.14 (2) (b) and 343.50 (4); and **to create** 343.14 (2g) of the  
2     statutes; **relating to:** the furnishing of social security numbers on applications  
3     for licenses and identification cards issued by the department of transportation  
4     and granting rule-making authority.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, any application for an operator's license or identification card issued by the department of transportation (DOT) must include the applicant's social security number. This bill provides a waiver from this requirement for an applicant on the ground that furnishing his or her social security number conflicts with the applicant's deeply held convictions. The bill requires DOT to promulgate rules governing eligibility for the waiver.
