



1995 SENATE BILL 667

March 27, 1996 - Introduced by Senators RUDE and RISSER, cosponsored by Representatives PROSSER and HUBER. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** general program operations of the state historical society
2 and making appropriations.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill increases funding for general program operations of the state historical society by \$201,700 for the 1996-97 fiscal year.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions; historical society.**

4 (1) GENERAL PROGRAM OPERATIONS; LIBRARY SERVICES. The authorized FTE
5 positions for the historical society, funded from the appropriation under section
6 20.245 (1) (am) of the statutes, are decreased by 0.25 GPR position on July 1, 1996,
7 for services for general program operations related to library services.

8 **SECTION 2. Appropriation changes; historical society.**

9 (1) GENERAL PROGRAM OPERATIONS.

10 (a) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation
11 to the historical society under section 20.245 (1) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the

1 acts of 1995, the dollar amount is increased by \$51,500 for fiscal year 1996–97 to
2 increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.

3 (b) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation
4 to the historical society under section 20.245 (1) (am) of the statutes, as affected by
5 the acts of 1995, the dollar amount is increased by \$50,000 for fiscal year 1996–97
6 to increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.

7 (c) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation
8 to the historical society under section 20.245 (2) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the
9 acts of 1995, the dollar amount is increased by \$10,700 for fiscal year 1996–97 to
10 increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.

11 (d) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation
12 to the historical society under section 20.245 (3) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the
13 acts of 1995, the dollar amount is increased by \$9,400 for fiscal year 1996–97 to
14 increase funding for the purposes for which the appropriation is made.

15 (e) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation
16 to the historical society under section 20.245 (4) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the
17 acts of 1995, the dollar amount is increased by \$95,800 for fiscal year 1996–97 to
18 increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made and to increase
19 the authorized FTE positions for the historical society by 0.75 GPR position for
20 services for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.

21 (f) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation
22 to the historical society under section 20.245 (5) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the
23 acts of 1995, the dollar amount is decreased by \$15,700 for fiscal year 1996–97 to

- 1 decrease the authorized FTE positions for the historical society by 0.5 GPR position
- 2 for services for general program operations of the historical society museum.
