



2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 352

April 24, 2001 - Introduced by Representatives SCHNEIDER, MUSSER, BOYLE, PETROWSKI, STONE, WADE, RYBA, GROTHMAN, BERCEAU, SHILLING and LA FAVE, cosponsored by Senator DARLING. Referred to Committee on Personal Privacy.

1 **AN ACT** *to renumber* 36.11 (35) (title); *to renumber and amend* 36.11 (35); and
2 *to create* 36.32 (1) of the statutes; **relating to:** the use of a person's social
3 security number in his or her student identification number at private
4 institutions of higher education.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the University of Wisconsin System, a technical college district board, a school board, and the governing body of a private school are prohibited from assigning to any student an identification number that is identical to or incorporates the student's social security number.

Beginning January 1, 2003, this bill extends this prohibition to private institutions of higher education located in this state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
