



2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 268

April 15, 2003 – Introduced by Representatives HAHN, HEBL, TURNER, MILLER, TOWNSEND, VAN ROY, GIELOW, HINES, BIES and BERCEAU, cosponsored by Senators CHVALA, WIRCH and M. MEYER. Referred to Committee on Transportation.

1 **AN ACT to create** 84.1026 of the statutes; **relating to:** designating and marking
2 a portion of STH 19 as the Georgia O’Keeffe Memorial Highway.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, certain highway routes and bridges have been designated and marked to memorialize, commemorate, or recognize certain individuals or events. This bill directs the Department of Transportation to designate and, upon receipt of sufficient contributions from interested parties, mark the route of STH 19 in this state from Sun Prairie to Marshall as the “Georgia O’Keeffe Memorial Highway” in recognition of the artistic contributions and accomplishments of Georgia O’Keeffe, who was born in the town of Sun Prairie in 1887. No state funds, other than from contributions from interested parties, may be used for the erection or maintenance of any markers on STH 19 to identify that portion of the highway as the “Georgia O’Keeffe Memorial Highway.”
