



2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 307

May 1, 2003 - Introduced by Representatives MUSSER, HINES, OTT, PETTIS and PLOUFF, cosponsored by Senator WIRCH. Referred to Committee on Government Operations and Spending Limitations.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 59.43 (2) (ag) 1. and 59.43 (2) (e) of the statutes; **relating to:**
2 fees received by a register of deeds.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Generally under current law, a register of deeds receives \$11 for recording or filing the first page of any document that is entitled to be recorded or filed with a register of deeds, and \$2 for each additional page.

Under this bill, a register of deeds receives \$3 for each additional page.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 59.43 (2) (ag) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:
4 59.43 (2) (ag) 1. Subject to s. 59.72 (5), for recording any instrument entitled
5 to be recorded in the office of the register of deeds, \$11 for the first page and \$2 ~~\$3~~
6 for each additional page, except that no fee may be collected for recording a change
7 of address that is exempt from a filing fee under s. 185.83 (1) (b).
