



## 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 860

February 21, 2008 – Introduced by Representative POCAN. Referred to Committee on Insurance.

1     **AN ACT** *to repeal* 20.515 (1) (bd); and *to create* 20.515 (1) (bd) of the statutes;  
2           **relating to:** payment of annual enrollment fees for participation in drug  
3           prescription benefit program administered by the Group Insurance Board and  
4           making an appropriation.

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### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

The Group Insurance Board (board) currently administers a drug prescription benefit program for the state and for any employer or person in this state who satisfies conditions for participation in the program. This program is called the BadgerRX Gold Program. For families and individuals, there is currently an annual enrollment fee to participate in the program. This bill prohibits the imposition of this fee during the remainder of 2008 and for all of 2009 and 2010. Instead, the state must pay the board, from general purpose revenues, an amount that the board would otherwise have received from these annual enrollment fees.
