



2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 258

September 15, 2011 - Introduced by Representatives E. COGGS and YOUNG.
Referred to Committee on Criminal Justice and Corrections.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** requiring the Department of Corrections to increase
2 participation in work release and treatment programs.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Corrections to increase by 200 in each year of the 2011-13 fiscal biennium, in a county having a population of 750,000 or more, the number of participants in its work release program and the number of participants in its treatment-based earned release program.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.**

4 (1) WORK RELEASE; INCREASES. The department of corrections shall increase, in
5 a county having a population of 750,000 or more, the number of participants in a
6 work release program under section 303.065 of the statutes by 200 in fiscal year
7 2011-12 and by 200 in fiscal year 2012-13.
