



## 2011 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 19

December 1, 2011 - Introduced by Representatives ROYS, BERCEAU, WYNN, C. TAYLOR, GRIGSBY, BEWLEY, CLARK, DOYLE, HEBL, JORGENSEN, KESSLER, MASON, POCAN and TURNER. Referred to Committee on Assembly Organization.

1     **To repeal** assembly rule 26 (7); and **to create** assembly rule 26 (8); **relating to:**  
2             conduct in the assembly visitor gallery.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This resolution amends the assembly rules to permit a person in the assembly visitor gallery to display a sign that is not larger than 8 1/2 inches in width and 11 inches in height, but only if the sign is not held over the person's head. In addition, the resolution amends the assembly rules to permit a person in the assembly visitor gallery to photograph or videotape any of the proceedings in the chamber.

### *Resolved by the assembly, That:*

4     **SECTION 1.** Assembly rule 26 (8) is created to read:

5             ASSEMBLY RULE 26 (8) A person in the visitor galleries may do any of the  
6     following:

7             (a) Display a sign that is not larger than 8 1/2 inches in width and 11 inches  
8     in height, but only if the sign is not held over the person's head.

9             (b) Photograph any of the proceedings in the chamber, but only with nonflash  
10     photography equipment.

1 (c) Videotape any of the proceedings in the chamber.

2 **SECTION 2.** Assembly rule 26 (7) is repealed.
