



2013 ASSEMBLY BILL 890

March 27, 2014 - Introduced by Representative YOUNG. Referred to Committee on Jobs, Economy and Mining.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** youth summer jobs programs in first class cities and making
2 an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, \$422,400 in general purpose revenues (GPR) is appropriated to the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) in each of fiscal years 2013-14 and 2014-15 for the implementation and operation of youth summer jobs programs in first class cities (presently only Milwaukee). This bill appropriates an additional \$1,000,000 in GPR to DWD in each of those fiscal years for that purpose.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1. Fiscal changes.**

1 amount is increased by \$1,000,000 for the first fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in
2 which this subsection takes effect for the purpose for which the appropriation is
3 made. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation
4 to the department of workforce development under section 20.445 (1) (fm) of the
5 statutes, as affected by the acts of 2013, the dollar amount is increased by \$1,000,000
6 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this subsection takes effect
7 for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.
