July 8, 2015 - Introduced by Representatives SKOWRONSKI, KOOYENGA, JACQUE, BARNES, SCHRAA, SUBECK, SINICKI, MURPHY, EDMING, WEATHERSTON and BERNIER, cosponsored by Senators LAZICH, VINEHOUT, WIRCH, COWLES, STROEBEL and OLSEN. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** declaring July 10, 2015, as Collector Car Appreciation Day in
2 Wisconsin.

3 Whereas, many people in Wisconsin and the nation maintain classic
4 automobiles as a pastime and do so with great passion and as a means of individual
5 expression; and

6 Whereas, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation issued more than 5,000
7 collector license plates in 2013; and

8 Whereas, classic and collector car clubs have been established throughout the
9 state in both small towns and large cities; and

10 Whereas, classic and collector car gatherings and “cruises” are held as a means
11 to improve the business climate in local communities; and

12 Whereas, the state legislature recognizes the effect that the more than
13 100-year history of the automobile has had on the economic progress of Wisconsin
14 and the United States and supports wholeheartedly all activities involved in the
15 restoration and exhibition of classic automobiles; and
