## 2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 429

June 30, 2017 - Introduced by Representatives SUBECK, ANDERSON, BERCEAU, KESSLER, OHNSTAD, C. TAYLOR, SARGENT, ZAMARRIPA and ZEPNICK, cosponsored by Senators L. TAYLOR, JOHNSON and LARSON. Referred to Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety.

1     **AN ACT to renumber and amend** 175.37 (1); **to amend** 175.37 (title) and 175.37  
2           (2); and **to create** 175.37 (1) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:** containers or  
3           trigger locks provided at a firearm sale and providing a criminal penalty.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill requires a person who commercially sells or transfers a firearm to provide the purchaser or transferee with either a secure, lockable container that is designed to store a firearm or a trigger lock for the firearm. A seller or transferor who violates this requirement is subject to a fine of up to \$500 or imprisonment for up to 30 days, or both.
