



## 2019 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 139

February 17, 2020 - Introduced by Representative VRUWINK. Referred to  
Committee on Rules.

1     **Relating to:** commending Abigail Martin for her service as Wisconsin's agriculture  
2             ambassador and wishing her continued success.

3             Whereas, when the Alice in Dairyland contest started in 1948, the winner was  
4     a beauty queen fresh out of high school; and

5             Whereas, today, Alice in Dairyland is a public relations professional with at  
6     least four years of experience or education in agriculture, public relations,  
7     communications, or related fields; and

8             Whereas, the job requirements include knowledge of Wisconsin's diverse  
9     agricultural products, history, and resources, as well as rural-urban issues; and

10            Whereas, in May 2019, after an intensive job interview process, Abigail Martin  
11     was named the 72nd Alice in Dairyland for a term of one year; and

12            Whereas, Abigail grew up on her family's 175-head dairy farm near Milton,  
13     Wisconsin, and graduated from the University of Wisconsin-Madison with a degree  
14     in dairy science; and

1           Whereas, as Wisconsin's agriculture ambassador, Abigail will travel 30,000  
2 miles throughout the state, giving speeches and media interviews, visiting trade  
3 shows, and educating the public about Wisconsin's rich dairy heritage; and

4           Whereas, Abigail brings an abundance of enthusiasm and an eloquent voice as  
5 she educates the public about the challenges and opportunities facing Wisconsin's  
6 agriculture industry; now, therefore, be it

7           ***Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That*** the Wisconsin  
8 State Legislature does hereby commend Abigail Martin for her service as Wisconsin's  
9 agriculture ambassador and wishes her continued success.
