## 2019 SENATE BILL 38

February 15, 2019 - Introduced by Senators DARLING, L. TAYLOR, NASS and MARKLEIN, cosponsored by Representatives ROHRKASTE, KOLSTE, CONSIDINE, FELZKOWSKI, BROOKS, KUGLITSCH, KULP, MILROY, MYERS, RAMTHUN, SINICKI, SKOWRONSKI, SPIROS, TUSLER, ZIMMERMAN, MEYERS and MURPHY. Referred to Committee on Health and Human Services.

1     **AN ACT** *to create* 450.03 (1) (j) of the statutes; **relating to:** dispensing,  
2             distributing, or selling dialysate, drugs, or devices necessary for providing  
3             home peritoneal kidney dialysis.

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***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill exempts persons dispensing, distributing, or selling dialysate, drugs, or devices necessary for providing home peritoneal kidney dialysis to a patient with end-stage renal disease from being required to obtain a pharmacist license. The exemption granted under the bill is subject to certain requirements, as detailed in the bill, including the following: 1) the dialysate, drugs, or devices are delivered in their original, sealed packaging from the manufacturing facility; 2) dispensing occurs only pursuant to a prescription order issued by a licensed physician; and 3) delivery is made only to a patient with end-stage renal disease, the patient's designee, or a health care provider for administration or delivery to a patient.

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***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

4             **SECTION 1.** 450.03 (1) (j) of the statutes is created to read:
