Senate Bill 144, relating to: entering into an agreement among the states to elect the president of the United States by means of a national popular vote., withdrawn from the committee on **Government Operations** and rereferred to the committee on **Shared Revenue, Elections and Consumer Protection**.

Senate Bill 261, relating to: regulation of tanning facilities., withdrawn from the committee on **Government Operations** and rereferred to the committee on **Shared Revenue, Elections and Consumer Protection**.

Senate Bill 104, relating to: eligibility for local office following removal., withdrawn from the committee on **Government Operations** and rereferred to the committee on **Shared Revenue, Elections and Consumer Protection**.

Senate Bill 39, relating to: absentee ballot request and return confirmation., withdrawn from the committee on **Government Operations** and rereferred to the committee on **Shared Revenue, Elections and Consumer Protection**.

Senate Bill 69, relating to: restoration of the right to vote to a person barred from voting as a result of a felony conviction., withdrawn from the committee on **Government Operations** and rereferred to the committee on **Shared Revenue, Elections and Consumer Protection**.

Senate Bill 88, relating to: whistleblower protection for municipal clerks who witness and report election fraud or irregularities., withdrawn from the committee on **Government Operations** and rereferred to the committee on **Shared Revenue, Elections and Consumer Protection**.

Senate Bill 26, relating to: removing ineligible voters from the official voter registration list., withdrawn from the committee on **Government Operations** and rereferred to the committee on **Shared Revenue, Elections and Consumer Protection**.

Senate Bill 98, relating to: verifying citizenship of individuals on the official voter registration list and contents of operator's licenses and identification cards., withdrawn from the committee on **Government Operations** and rereferred to the committee on **Shared Revenue, Elections and Consumer Protection**.
