Analysis Prepared by the Department of Transportation

General summary of rule. This order creates s. Trans 111.02(6) and s. Trans 111.13 to establish by rule the department's policies and procedures relating to issuing special restricted operator licenses to persons between the ages of 14 and 16.

Statutory interpretations and policies included in the rule are:

1. Trans 111.02(6) prescribes that an applicant between the ages of 14 and 16 must obtain a written statement from a physician indicating that the applicant is physically disabled before being considered for a special restricted operator's license under s. 343.135, Stats.

2. Trans 111.13 provides that a person applying for a special restricted operator's license does not have to take the driving ability examination if his or her physical or mental condition has not changed during the past two years. This section is created as required by 1983 Wisconsin Act 243, Sections 26 and 28.

Fiscal estimate. There is no anticipated fiscal effect on state or local government.

Forms. There are no new or revised state forms as a result of this proposal.

Pursuant to authority vested in the department of transportation by ss. 110.06, 227.014, and 343.135, Stats., the department hereby adopts a rule interpreting s. 343.135, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section Trans 111.02(6) is created to read:


(6) As provided by s. 343.135, Stats., a person who is at least 14 years of age but who has not attained the age of 16 shall be considered for a special restricted operator's license only after the department receives a written statement from a physician that the person is physically disabled.

SECTION 2. Section Trans 111.13 is created to read:

Trans 111.13 RENEWAL PROVISION. As provided by s. 343.135, Stats., a person whose physical or mental condition has not changed during the past two years shall not be required to perform the driving ability examination for operation of a moped or motor bicycle.

The rules contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication as provided in s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats.
