



1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 464

June 26, 1995 - Introduced by Representatives KREUSER, ROBSON, BELL and MORRIS-TATUM, cosponsored by Senator ANDREA, by request of Carol Fischer. Referred to Committee on Education.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 118.29 (title) and 118.29 (5) of the statutes; **relating to:** the
2 performance of medical procedures by school district employes who are not
3 health care professionals.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, no school district employe who is not a health care professional may be required to administer a drug to a pupil by any means other than ingestion.

This bill provides that no employe except a health care professional may be required to perform any other medical procedure except as specified in the person's employment contract.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 118.29 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:
5 **118.29 (title) Administration of drugs to pupils and; emergency care,**
6 **medical procedures.**
7 **SECTION 2.** 118.29 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:
8 118.29 (5) EXEMPTION. No employe except a health care professional may be
9 required to administer a drug or prescription drug to a pupil under this section by

1 any means other than ingestion. No employe except a health care professional may
2 be required to perform any other medical procedure except as specified in his or her
3 employment contract.
