1     **Relating to:** commending Bruce Feustel on his service to the Wisconsin legislature  
2             and the Legislative Reference Bureau.

3             Whereas, Bruce Feustel has assumed a challenging new position with the  
4     National Conference of State Legislatures in Denver after more than 20 years of  
5     distinguished service as an attorney in the Wisconsin Legislative Reference Bureau;  
6     and

7             Whereas, during his long tenure at the LRB, Bruce became a master in the  
8     difficult subjects of criminal law, corrections and the courts; and

9             Whereas, Bruce used his mastery of those subjects to provide wise counsel to  
10    many dozens of legislators; and

11            Whereas, Bruce also became an expert drafter and was able to use his  
12    considerable verbal and analytical abilities to produce legislation that accurately  
13    reflected his requesters' intent, regardless of the complexity of the tasks that they  
14    assigned him; and

15            Whereas, Bruce performed for the LRB many other valuable services, such as  
16    training inexperienced attorneys, aiding in the evaluation of prospective employes,

1 providing counsel to the LRB's managers, and serving as a liaison to other state  
2 agencies; and

3 Whereas, dozens of former and present LRB employes owe Bruce gratitude for  
4 his unflagging friendship, his humanity, and his sensitivity to their needs; and

5 Whereas, Bruce has been active in the National Conference of State  
6 Legislatures: training attorneys, presiding over the legal services staff section, and  
7 serving as a member of the executive committee; and

8 Whereas, Bruce has also actively participated in the Madison community by  
9 counseling victims of childhood abuse, volunteering for the parental stress hotline  
10 and helping to organize and administer running events; and

11 Whereas, Bruce's concern for his family, friends, colleagues and others has  
12 made him a model for many to emulate; now, therefore, be it

13 ***Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That*** the members of the  
14 legislature of the state of Wisconsin express their heartfelt gratitude to Bruce  
15 Feustel for his many years of excellent and conscientious service to them and to the  
16 Legislative Reference Bureau and wish him well; and, be it further

17 ***Resolved, That*** the assembly chief clerk shall provide a copy of this joint  
18 resolution to Bruce Feustel.
