



## 1995 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 85

February 29, 1996 - Introduced by Representatives TRAVIS, PROSSER, KUNICKI, R. YOUNG, BLACK and BALDWIN, cosponsored by Senators RISSER, WINEKE and CHVALA. Referred to Calendar.

1     **Relating to:** the life and public service of Frank Remington.

2             Whereas, Frank Remington was born on February 10, 1922, in Schenectady,  
3     New York, and died on February 9, 1996, in Madison; and

4             Whereas, Mr. Remington served in the U.S. Army Air Force during World War  
5     II and won the Distinguished Flying Cross; and

6             Whereas, he earned undergraduate and law degrees from the University of  
7     Wisconsin-Madison, finishing first in his law school class and serving as editor in  
8     chief of the Wisconsin Law Review; and

9             Whereas, he taught at the University of Wisconsin-Madison Law School for 46  
10    years and attained national stature as an authority on criminal law and procedure,  
11    as evidenced by his many publications and his appointment to prestigious positions;

13            Whereas, he worked on the committees that drafted the Federal Rules of  
14    Criminal Procedure and the American Law Institute's Model Penal Code and, for the  
15    American Bar Association, he directed a study of criminal justice administration and  
16    a project to develop standards for police officers; and
