



1995 SENATE BILL 600

March 5, 1996 - Introduced by Senators DRZEWIECKI, ZIEN, ANDREA, BURKE, GROBSCHMIDT, SHIBILSKI and COWLES, cosponsored by Representatives PORTER, DOBYNS, WIRCH, URBAN, RYBA, MURAT, GROTHMAN, GARD, LORGE, SERATTI and KREUSER. Referred to Committee on Transportation, Agriculture and Local Affairs.

1 **AN ACT to create** 84.1044 of the statutes; **relating to:** designating STH 160 as
2 the “Polish Veterans Memorial Highway”.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the department of transportation to designate and mark the entire route of STH 160 as the “Polish Veterans Memorial Highway” to honor Polish military veterans of the U.S. armed forces. The bill prohibits the expenditure of state funds to erect any designating markers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 84.1044 of the statutes is created to read:
4 **84.1044 Polish Veterans Memorial Highway.** (1) In recognition of their
5 courageous, dutiful and selfless service to this state and the U.S. armed forces, the
6 department shall designate STH 160, commencing at STH 29 at Angelica and
7 proceeding easterly to STH 32 at Pulaski, as the “Polish Veterans Memorial
8 Highway” to commemorate and honor the exceptional military service and
9 patriotism shown by this state’s Polish veterans throughout its history.
