



## 1995 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 8

February 14, 1995 – Introduced by Senator JAUCH, cosponsored by Representative BOYLE.

1     **Relating to** the life and public service of Elmer C. Peterson.

2           Whereas, Elmer C. Peterson was born in Martin County, Minnesota, on  
3     November 30, 1892, and died on June 19, 1978; and

4           Whereas, he was educated in the public schools of Rockford, Illinois, and at  
5     Brown's Business College; and

6           Whereas, he served with the U.S. Army in a mortar battery unit during World  
7     War I; and

8           Whereas, he served as a town clerk, a school clerk, a town chairperson and a  
9     member of a county board; and

10          Whereas, Mr. Peterson was the president of the Douglas County Farmers  
11     Union from 1931 to 1938; and

12          Whereas, he served in the assembly from 1931 to 1938 and in the senate from  
13     1943 to 1944; and

14          Whereas, he held public office continuously from 1926 to 1944; now, therefore,  
15     be it

1           ***Resolved by the senate, the Assembly concurring, That*** the members of the  
2 legislature of the state of Wisconsin salute Elmer C. Peterson's many devoted years  
3 of public service and express their sorrow at his death.
