2	Whereas, Stephen E. Fredrick was born on December 15, 1945, in
3	Farmersburg, Iowa, and died in rural Mindoro on February 18, 1997; and
4	Whereas, Stephen Fredrick was a highly respected educator in the Coulee
5	region and a great sportsman; and
6	Whereas, Mr. Fredrick had a long and prestigious career in the field of
7	education, serving as an English teacher, the Melrose-Mindoro High School
8	principal and a district administrator; and
9	Whereas, Mr. Fredrick was an effective and tireless advocate for education and
10	for providing a safe and effective learning environment for his students; and
11	Whereas, Mr. Fredrick served his country with pride and distinction in Vietnam
12	in the 101st Airborne Division as a combat platoon sergeant, earning a Bronze Star,
13	2 Air Medals and the Combat Infantryman's Badge; and
14	Whereas, Mr. Fredrick will be greatly missed by his family, friends, school
