



1997 SENATE BILL 232

June 10, 1997 - Introduced by Senators WELCH, ZIEN, ROESSLER and DRZEWIECKI, cosponsored by Representatives OWENS, RYBA, MUSSER, LORGE, KREIBICH, DOBYNS, GREEN, WARD, HANDRICK, TURNER, GROTHMAN, BRANDEMUEHL, SCHAFFER, FREESE, ALBERS, SERATTI, HAHN, BOYLE, GUNDERSON, POWERS, PORTER, KLUSMAN and NASS. 1 **AN ACT to create** 71.75 (11) of the statutes; **relating to:** income tax refunds for
2 certain disabled veterans.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the department of revenue to issue an income tax refund to an individual who is otherwise eligible to receive a refund if the individual received separation pay from the U.S. military, paid income tax on the amount received and then had his or her status changed by the federal government such that the military considers the payment to have been a disability payment.
