February 25, 1997 - Introduced by Senators CLAUSING, WINEKE, SCHULTZ, DECKER, MOEN and BRESKE, cosponsored by Representatives SKINDRUD, GRONEMUS, SPRINGER, SERATTI, REYNOLDS, DUEHOLM, R. YOUNG, VANDER LOOP, BLACK, BOCK, ROBSON, CARPENTER, L. YOUNG, BAUMGART, HASENOHRL, NOTESTEIN, BOYLE and RYBA. Referred to Committee on Agriculture and Environmental Resources.

1 AN ACT *to repeal* 115.343 (4); and *to amend* 20.255 (2) (cp) of the statutes;
2 relating to: the Wisconsin morning milk program and making an
3 appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill changes the appropriation that funds the Wisconsin morning milk program from a sum certain to a sum sufficient.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 SECTION 1. 20.255 (2) (cp) of the statutes is amended to read:
5 20.255 (2) (cp) *Wisconsin morning milk program.* ~~The amounts in the schedule~~
6 A sum sufficient for the Wisconsin morning milk program under s. 115.343.

7 SECTION 2. 115.343 (4) of the statutes is repealed.
