



## 1999 SENATE BILL 403

February 23, 2000 – Introduced by Senators SHIBILSKI and SCHULTZ, cosponsored by Representatives ALBERS, LASSA, MUSSER, WARD, SPILLNER, KLUSMAN and GUNDERSON. Referred to Joint committee on Information Policy.

1     **AN ACT** *to renumber* 44.70 (1); *to amend* 16.974 (7) (a), 20.275 (1) (s) (title) and  
2             44.70 (2g); and *to create* 44.70 (1g) of the statutes; **relating to:** eligibility of  
3             certain athletic associations for financial assistance for telecommunications  
4             access.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, certain educational agencies, such as school districts, may request financial assistance that is administered by the technology for educational achievement in Wisconsin board for access to either one data line or video link. This bill specifies that athletic associations are also eligible for such financial assistance. The bill defines “athletic association” as a nonprofit corporation that coordinates athletic events or contests for students enrolled in grades 9 to 12. Financial assistance to athletic associations is made from the appropriation under current law for providing assistance to school districts.
