



## 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 859

February 26, 2002 – Introduced by Representatives BOYLE, RICHARDS, SINICKI, REYNOLDS, SCHNEIDER, POCAN and BERCEAU. Referred to Committee on Natural Resources.

1     **AN ACT** *to create* 29.318 of the statutes; **relating to:** prohibiting the hunting of  
2           mourning doves and requiring a referendum.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under rules promulgated by the department of natural resources (DNR), there is an open season for the hunting of mourning doves.

This bill prohibits DNR from authorizing an open season for the hunting of mourning doves and imposes a specific ban against the hunting of these doves.

The bill, however, does not take effect until there is submitted to the vote of the electors at the general election in November 2002 the question “Shall section 1 of 2001 Wisconsin Act .... (this act), which prohibits the hunting of mourning doves, become law effective January 1, 2003?,” and the question is approved by a majority of all votes cast on the question at the election.
